
The City of Agoura Hills Department of Community Services is please to announce that we will be offering on-line registration beginning in Winter 2013!

We will be partnering with Active Network, Inc. to provide class and event registration. The Active Network has been providing class and event services for over 20 years, and over 1,200 state and local parks and recreation agencies currently use their products.

With ActiveNet, you will be able to search and view hundreds of our classes and programs on-line, and register without having to leave home!

Some of the benefits of registering on-line include:

- Ability to register for classes for yourself and other family members
- Ability to view your past class registrations with ActiveNet
- Ability to view and print class schedules
- Ability to see "at a glance" where you need to be, and when!
- Manage your own account and make payments from the comfort of your own home



There will be a \$2 convenience fee that ActiveNet assesses when you register on-line, which is due at the time of payment. These fees are collected by the Active Network to offset the costs of providing the service, and are not collected by the City of Agoura Hills. WHAT IS CERT?

Local government prepares for everyday emergencies. However, during a large disaster, the number and scope of incidents can overwhelm conventional emergency services. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT); traditionally known as the Disaster Response Team (DRT) in Agoura Hills; is designed to educate residents and businesses about emergency preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and instructs them in basic disaster response skills. Using the skills learned in the classroom and during exercises,

CERT-trained DRT members can give critical support to their families, neighbors, and community immediately following a disaster when residents may initially be on their own and emergency services may not be available to help.

WHY WAS THE CERT PROGRAM DEVELOPED?

The CERT training program was developed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and modeled after the original 1985 programs used by the City of Los Angeles Fire Department. The purpose of the CERT program is to create a well-trained citizen emergency work force which is vital in the immediate aftermath of disaster situations when the number and scope of incidents overwhelm conventional emergency services.

WHY DO THE CERT TRAINING?

CERT members are primarily used in their own neighborhoods. CERT training means you are as ready as you can be to help yourself, your family, and your

neighborhood, and serves as the basic level of training for all community-based disaster volunteer teams. In a disaster, normal activities will be disrupted; sheriff, fire, 9-1-1, and ambulances will be quickly overwhelmed and may not be able to respond for 72 hours. Residents need to be able to take care of themselves until the professional emergency responders arrive. One goal of the CERT program is to help residents respond to and assist others in need and do so effectively without placing themselves in unnecessary danger.

REFUND, TRANSFER AND CREDITS POLICY

GENERAL

1. This policy applies to all department-sponsored programs, activities and special instruction classes.
2. Request for refund, transfer or credit may be made by telephone or in person prior to the start of classes/camp.
3. All refunds, transfers or credits must be called in during business hours one business day prior to the start of class/camp. Business hours are Monday through Thursday from 7:00am–6:00pm, and on Friday from 7:00am–4:00pm. Requests for refunds, transfers or credits left on the answering machine will not be honored. Refunds, transfers or credits requested prior to the start of the second class will be issued on a pro-rated basis. **NO REFUNDS, TRANSFERS OR CREDITS AFTER THE SECOND CLASS.**
4. Any cancellations made the day of camp (individual day camps only) will only be issued in the form of credit on account. Account credit will be kept on file for two years. There are no refunds for credit on account.
5. There are no refunds, transfers or credits for sports/specialty camps once camp has begun. Any refunds for sports/specialty camps must be called in one business day prior to the start of camp.
6. No refunds, transfers or credits will be granted if cancellations for any program are made after the stated deadline, or if the program specifically states **NO REFUNDS** (unless cancelled by the department).
7. There are no refunds for Fitness Passes.
8. There is a \$5 processing fee for all refunds.
9. All refunds under \$10 (after processing fee and any pro-rated fees are taken out) will be issued in the form of a credit coupon. Credit coupons are good for two years.
10. All lab/materials fees are non-refundable and are due to the instructor on the first day of class/camp.
11. There is a \$10 charge on all returned checks.

*The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children before or after scheduled programs. Therefore, it is important that parents do not send children early for camps and classes and see to it that they are picked up on time. If a child is picked up late from a program, a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every thirty minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class/excursion. No exceptions! Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30 minute violation and a fine will be imposed.

**There is a \$10 service charge on all checks returned from the bank. Payment must either be cash, cashier's check or money order.


